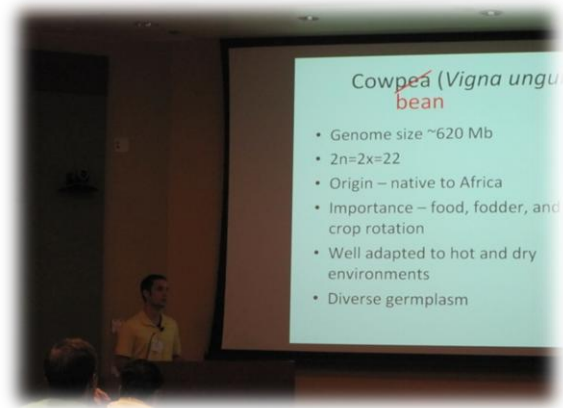

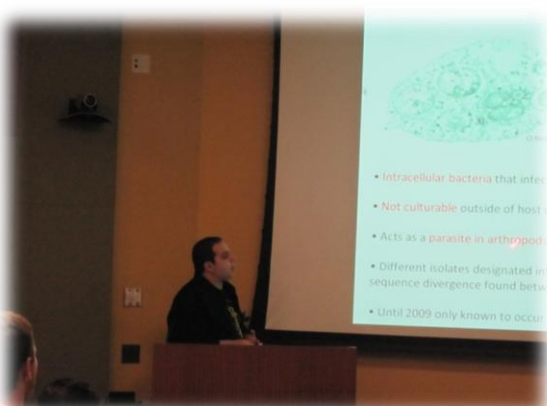

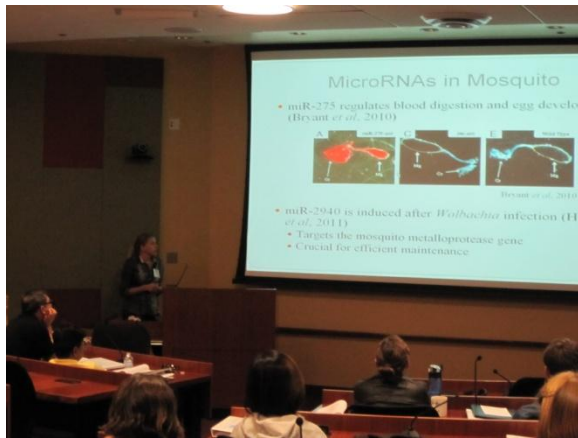


- Cowpea (Vigna unguiculata) bean**
- Genome size ~620 Mb
 - $2n=2x=22$
 - Origin – native to Africa
 - Importance – food, fodder, and crop rotation
 - Well adapted to hot and dry environments
 - Diverse germplasm
